

EOC Testing

Incoming freshmen in 2010–2011 and beyond must pass three EOC tests in the following categories: English II or English III, Algebra I or Geometry, and Biology or American History. The EOC tests replace the Graduation Exit Examination (GEE) for graduation purposes.

There are four achievement levels students can score on the End-of-Course exams: *Excellent*, *Good*, *Fair* and *Needs Improvement*.

Students are required to score *Fair* or above on EOC English II or English III, Algebra I or Geometry, and Biology or American History to be eligible for a standard high school diploma.

A rating of *Needs Improvement* indicates a student has not demonstrated the fundamental knowledge and skills for the next level of coursework in the subject area.

Students who did not score *Fair* or above on an EOC test may retest in the next EOC administration. Students shall be offered 30 hours of remediation each year in each EOC test they do not pass.
